

Transferring Credits

Incoming graduate students who have completed graduate coursework at another institution can transfer in up to 12 credits of prior graduate coursework, and incoming graduate students who have completed graduate coursework at UNLV can transfer in up to 15 such credits (using the *Transfer Credit Request* form), if that coursework was not completed as a part of credits earned (whether required or elective) for a prior degree, and if the coursework is relevant to the program of study. All incoming graduate students can file an appeal (using the *Appeal* form) to have additional credits of prior graduate coursework that meets the afore-referenced stipulations considered for transfer.

Course Substitutions
