Cognate Courses – Credits: 6

Complete 6 credits of advisor-approved cognate coursework. Courses can be chosen from any department on campus, but must be 600-level or above, and must be related in some way (e.g., be in the same department, be on a related theme, focus on the topic from different disciplinary points of entry, etc.). Courses chosen can include, but do not have to include, any CME course not already completed.

Culminating Experience – Credits: 1

CIG 697: Curriculum and Instruction Culminating Experience—Multicultural Education

(Students may enroll in CIG 697 after they have completed 27 credits. Students must be co-enrolled in at least one 3-credit course during the semester they complete CIG 697 or they must enroll in CIG 697 for 3 credits instead of 1 credit.)
